What is being awarded

TiE-DC presents four awards at the 2026 Awards Gala on Saturday, November 14. Three are open to nomination from anyone in the region. The Lifetime Achievement Award is selected by the TiE-DC board and is not open to nomination.

Visionary Entrepreneur of the Year

Founder led company in DC, Maryland, or Northern Virginia, operating five or more years.

Catalyst Award

An individual or institution responsible for the growth of two or more regional ventures.

Emerging Entrepreneur of the Year

Company under five years old, pre Series B or under \$5M revenue, regional headquarters.

What a nomination requires

- A completed form for one category. A nominee may be entered in only one category.
- A nomination statement of up to 500 words.
- Five short answers of up to 100 words each. Each answer maps to one scoring criterion.
- Optional supporting links. No attachments over 10MB.
- Confirmation that the nominee knows they have been nominated and will attend if named a finalist.

How nominations are judged

A jury of five scores every eligible nomination against a published rubric, on five criteria, using a one to five scale. Criteria are weighted differently by category. The three highest scores in each category become finalists. Self nomination is permitted and is not scored differently. Jurors declare conflicts and do not score nominations they are connected to. A sponsor holding a jury seat does not score the category their firm sponsors.

The five criteria are impact and results, innovation and originality, growth and trajectory, contribution to the regional ecosystem, and leadership and integrity. The full rubric is published separately and is available on request.

How to submit

Email the completed form to exec@tie-dc.org with the subject line "2026 Award Nomination, [category], [nominee name]." Nominations received after 11:59pm Eastern on September 8, 2026 are not considered. You will receive an acknowledgment within two business days. If you do not, assume the nomination was not received and resend.

Write with specifics. Numbers, dates, and named outcomes score higher than adjectives. A nomination that says "grew rapidly" scores below one that says "grew from 8 to 47 employees between 2024 and 2026."

1. Impact and results. What has the company achieved? Give figures: revenue, customers, employees, capital raised.

2. Innovation and originality. What is original about the product, model, or approach?

3. Growth and trajectory. What changed over the last 24 months, and what is credibly next for the company?

4. Contribution to the ecosystem. How has the nominee mentored, hired, invested in, or strengthened the regional community?

5. Leadership and integrity. How were these results achieved, and what culture did the nominee build?

4. Contribution to the ecosystem. Beyond individual companies, what has the nominee built, funded, or taught?

5. Leadership and integrity. How does the nominee behave when a venture struggles or a deal goes against them?

4. Contribution to the ecosystem. How does the nominee engage with and give back to the founder community?

5. Leadership and integrity. How is the nominee building the team and setting standards for growth?
